

Code of Conduct of
Kappa Kappa Psi
Theta Upsilon Chapter
University of Rhode Island

Kappa Kappa Psi is a national honorary fraternity designed to recognize outstanding members of college and university bands. The Theta Upsilon chapter of Kappa Kappa Psi believes in encouraging the highest standard of conduct in its members. Brothers should strive to serve as role models within the band program. To this end, Brothers and Prospective Members of the Theta Upsilon chapter of Kappa Kappa Psi should subscribe to the following:

- The Theta Upsilon chapter of Kappa Kappa Psi does not condone or promote the practice of underage drinking. Brothers of the Theta Upsilon chapter shall not engage in the consumption of alcohol at any Chapter or Fraternity event, nor shall they do so at any time when wearing Fraternal letters or any regalia of the Fraternity.
- The Theta Upsilon chapter of Kappa Kappa Psi does not condone or promote the consumption of illicit drugs or the utilizing of prescription medication in a manner inconsistent with its intended use.
- When representing the Chapter in public, Brothers should ensure that language used and topics of conversation are representative of the high ideals of the fraternity.
- At all times, conversation between Brothers should be respectful, even in disagreement. No personal attack should be made on one Brother by another.
- Brothers shall remember that the primary purpose of attending the university is academic in nature. At no time shall a Brother allow Chapter functions to interfere with the completion of academic responsibilities.
- Brothers shall respect the sanctity of other musical organizations. Brothers shall not disseminate privileged information of other said organizations, nor shall they willfully act in any way which would cause disharmony with those organizations.
