Service Showcase's New Look



The Service Showcase Program has never solidified since its inception in 2001-2002. The reason I can readily name this date is because I was district president the year it started. Originally, each district would find a method to select a recipient of the Service

Showcase and then that would be forwarded to the national council. The National Council would then make a contribution of \$200 to the band programs at each school. Finally, the projects would be compiled and sent to directors across the nation to "Showcase" outstanding

service projects of the biennium.

However, this system has not allowed for proper supervision and a lot of confusion of this program over the years. First, having a national program that ultimately is not under the supervision on the

national council has led to confusion. Each of our six districts has various views on what this program actually entails. We have some districts who have completely embraced this program, but we have some districts that have not explored this program.

This year at national convention the Programs Committee reviewed this program. From that discussion and their recommendations the following changes will occur.

1. Since the Service Showcase is a national program, it will be overseen by the National Vice President for Programs and the National Council.
2. The National VP for Programs will create a submission form for chapters.
3. All submissions will be due on January 1st and July 1st to correspond with similar programs.
4. The National Council will select the strongest programs for the Service Showcase.
5. Those programs will be shared in a national format such as conventions and The Podium in coordination with the National VP for Professional Relations
6. The selected schools band programs will still receive a monetary award in recognition of their chapters service.

If you have any questions about this format please let me know. It is important that we begin to move forward on this program. If you feel that your district is losing a great way to recognize service, then I challenge you to create a program on that level.
