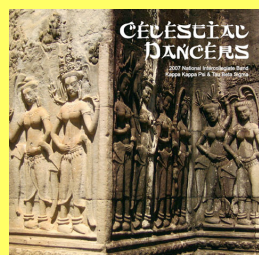

Did you know that Kappa Kappa Psi has a Matching Grant Program? This program will help your school bring in a guest performer. This matching grant of up to \$500 dollars has three basic criteria

1. The funded project will include at least one public performance by one or more of the college/university concert bands featuring the guest conductor(s) and/or performing artist(s).

2. The funded project will be student-centered, with a clear

focus to the improvement of teaching and learning through workshops, master classes, and/or clinics provided by the guest conductor(s) and/or performing artist(s).

3. The funded project will clearly demonstrate the standard of excellence and musical achievements of the guest conductor(s) and/or performing artist(s).

Any accredited college band program in the country may apply for this award regardless of affiliation with Kappa Kappa Psi. Application are accepted year round. (<http://>
