ı	Letter of Support from the Dean of Students (or campus equivalent)
	Letter of Support from the Director of Bands (If there is no one with this title, please contact the Department Chair, Dean of the College or other supervisory individual for this correct person to complete this letter)
l	(Optional) Letter of Support from Associate/Assistant Director of Bands
ĺ	Overview of the Band Program History and Accomplishments
l	At least ten (10) Petitioning Members that reflects a diverse population of band members.
l	The petitioning president should also include an overview of the recruitment process that was used to select members.

THE PETITIONING GROUP APPLICATION

Some other notes about the Petitioning Group application:

- Submitting an application does not guarantee a Petitioning Group
- There is \$150 non-refundable application fee
- Dues increased at this past National Convention. Two weeks prior to Installation, the following dues must be paid to our National HQ
 - \$150 per Petitioning Group member and Honorary Member
 - \$300 One Time Charter Fee







Starting in the Spring of 2024, the Petitioning Group Process will be in three phases aligned with our Friend and Advocate Initiative. They will be:

- Phase I Education and Chapter Installation
- Phase II Operations and Chapter Identity
- Phase III Continued Support







Phase I will be up to eight weeks. We will cover the basics of Chapter Operations and the Road to Wisdom, our National Membership Education Program. These weeks are:

- Week 1. Lesson 0 Orientation.
- Week 2. Lesson 1 Our Service.
- Week 3. Lesson 2 Our Leadership.
- Week 4. First and Second Degree. (*Ideally in-person on a weekend*)







Phase I will be up to eight weeks. We will cover the basics of Chapter Operations and the Road to Wisdom, our National Membership Education Program. These weeks are:

- Week 5. Lesson 3 Our Musicianship.
- Week 6. Lesson 4 Our Brotherhood.
- Week 7. Third Degree and Chapter Installation. (*Ideally in-person on a weekend*)
- Week 8. Lesson 5 Our Journey.







Phase II will focus on Chapter Identity and Operations and will have three additional lessons, namely:

- Your Chapter 'House' A session where you work on defining what your ideal chapter is
- Chapter Operations Your Year in Review and Recruitment Plan
- Chapter Operations Developing Fundraises and Service Projects

Phase III will provided continued support from Advisors.







Other notes on the Petitioning Group Process:

- If your university requires a faster timeline, we can accommodate
- Regardless of when your Chapter is installed (Spring or Fall), Annual National Dues are due *September 30th*
 - Post Initiation, annual dues are \$130 for the 2023-2025 Biennium alongside a \$100 Chapter Fee
